A PROCLAMATION TO DESIGNATE THE THIRD SATURDAY OF OCTOBER EACH YEAR AS A DAY TO CELEBRATE THE MANY BLESSINGS OF THE FALL HARVEST AND THE BOUNTY OF OUR LAND THROUGH THE ALBANY FALL FESTIVAL.

WHEREAS, the Village of Albany and the Greater Albany Area each have their own geographic flavor and historic personality but together form a dynamic community with a strong volunteer spirit, and

WHEREAS, The Albany Fall Festival, which is sponsored by local businesses, groups, and individuals, promises on the third Saturday of October each year to be a spectacular family fun day. Highlights of the day shall include a parade, business and community showcase, food court, and local crafts and music, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Albany has agreed to host, on public streets, a street fair celebrating our beautiful community and the annual harvest of farm and field while also promoting unity and economic development and offering residents the opportunity to meet friends and neighbors from the Greater Albany Area and everywhere in-between.
