• **Duties:**

- Patrol the Village to maintain order.
- Enforce laws and ordinances.
- Investigate complaints, accidents, crime reports and prepares reports.
- Appear as witness in court when necessary.
- Perform public relation activities.
- Any other duties assigned by the Chief of Police.

• **Employment Requirements:**

- Be a United States citizen at least 18 years of age.
- Possess a valid Driver's License.
- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- Successfully complete the minimum training required for licensure to include the current Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy course.
- Never have been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or is not currently under indictment for any criminal offense.
- Be free of misdemeanor convictions for the last twelve [12] months, other than traffic offenses.
- Have no previous or current charges of driving while intoxicated or driving under the Influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Never been convicted of any family violence offense.
- Not be prohibited by state or federal law from operating a motor vehicle.
- Not be prohibited by state or federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition.
- Be subject to a thorough background investigation, lie detector test, etc.
