### Changes to Line 7 A & N

**ATHENS, OH** – Effective Monday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, Athens Public Transit would like to announce that Line 7 which runs to Nelsonville and Albany will be adjusting their stop times by 15 minutes. The change in time will allow riders to have a direct connection to Line 3 and Line 6, which will create easier access to places like East State Street, The Plains, and Chauncey. Line 7 will begin running at 7am from the Ohio University Baker Center and the last drop off will be at 7pm at Baker Center.
