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Excavation Permit

GENERAL PROVISIONS AS THEY APPLY TO AN EXCAVATION PERMIT.

The Village of Albany has adopted rules and regulations for excavations within the Village pursuant to <u>Village Code Chapter 152</u>, a complete copy of which is available upon request. A few of those regulations are included below to assist you with your project:

- Said regulations prohibit any tunnel, opening, or excavation of any kind under the surface of any property without first securing an Excavation Permit from the Village for each undertaking. The acceptance of this permit or doing any work thereunder shall constitute an agreement by the party or parties to which the permit is granted, to comply with all the conditions and restriction of the Excavation Permit and all other regulations, codes, and ordinances of the Village of Albany.
- The permittee upon completion of the work shall leave the public right of way clean of all rubbish, excess materials, temporary structures, and equipment, and all parts of the roadway shall be left in an acceptable condition.
- The permittee shall save harmless the Village of Albany, and all of their respective representatives from all suits, actions, or claims of any character, brought on account of any injuries or damages sustained by any person or property in consequence of any neglect or on account of any act or omission as a result of the issuance of this permit. All work shall be performed in accordance with the OSHA Safety Standards in effect at the date of this permit.
- Section 3781.28 of the Ohio Revised Code requires excavators to notify the Ohio Utility Protection Service (OUPS) at least 48 hours but not more than 10 days BEFORE COMMENCING excavation. The phone number for OUPS is 1-800-362-2764.

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
